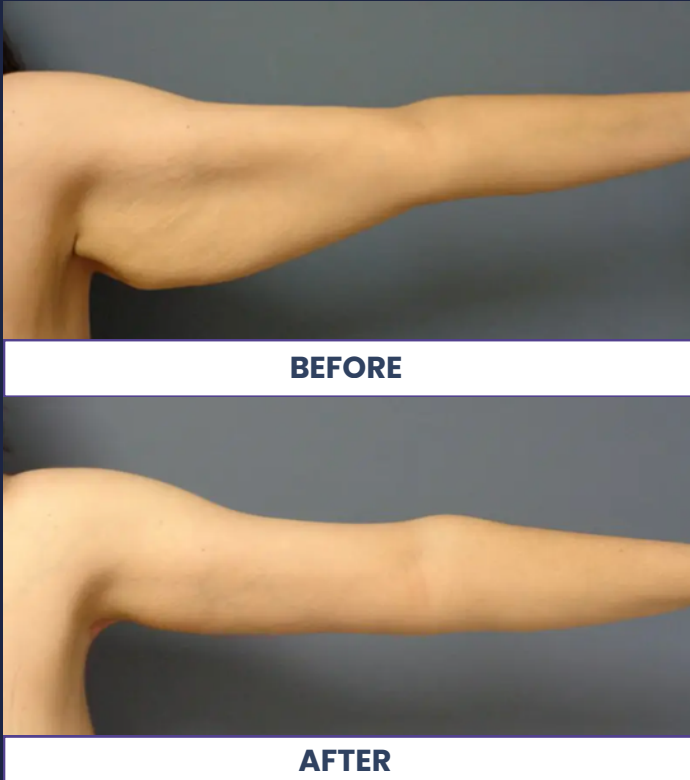

Arm Lift vs. Arm Liposuction: What's the Difference?



If your upper arms are an area you've been wanting to address, the right procedure depends on what's causing your concern.

Arm liposuction is designed to remove localized pockets of stubborn fat and may be a good option for patients who still have good skin elasticity. Once the excess fat is removed, the skin has the ability to naturally conform to the new contour.

An arm lift, also known as brachioplasty, addresses excess or sagging skin that may develop with age or following significant weight loss. During the procedure, excess skin and localized fat can be removed while the underlying supportive tissue is tightened to create a smoother, more defined upper arm.
